8. EASE 2020 Conference

Two regions (Korea and Hong Kong) indicated interest to host the EASE 2020 conference. They were invited to present their proposal at the coming EM meeting. Each region presented for at most 10 minutes and the decision was made by voting during which EMs of the two regions which were involved in the bidding did not participate in the voting. It was then agreed that Korea will host the EASE conference in 2020.
