◆ At the 2022 EASE online conference, many science educators and researchers were registered. When they registered at the conference, they were counted as membership registration of EASE. The total number of membership during the 2022 conference was 127 .

◆ In September 1 of 2021, the funding was transferred from Japan to Korea. Korea received KRW 27,976,644 (USD 24,410.30; ER 1146KRW/USD) from Japan.

◆ After Korea hosted the 2022 conference of EASE, the account's net balance as of November 17, 2022 was KRW 29,246,396. In December 2022, the balance of KRW 29,246,396 (IDR 344,565,000. ER 8.48 IDR/KRW; 23,190 USD equivalent. ER 1,260 KRW/USD) was carried over to Indonesia.
